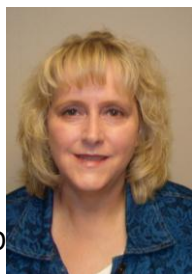
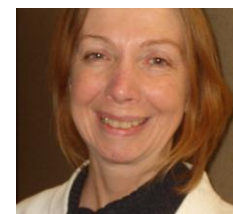

CCLC is a private Non-profit corporation governed by a board of directors. CCLC's mission is to assess, promote, and provide education and employment services to area workforce and employers.



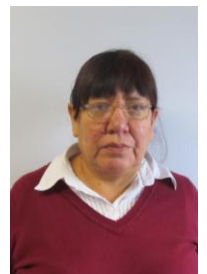
